RE: **TRAVEL-PROHIBITED STATES FOR STATE-FUNDED AND STATE-SPONSORED TRAVEL**

On Friday, July 14, 2023, the Office of the Attorney General added three states to the list of travel-prohibited states for all state-funded and state-sponsored travel: Missouri, Nebraska, and Wyoming. Per [Assembly Bill AB 1887](#), the following states are currently subject to California's ban on state-funded and state-sponsored travel:

- Arizona
- Arkansas
- Florida
- Georgia
- Idaho
- Indiana
- Iowa
- Kansas
- Kentucky
- Louisiana
- Mississippi
- **Missouri – NEW (Effective August 28, 2023)**
- Montana
- **Nebraska – NEW (Effective October 1, 2023)**
- North Carolina
- North Dakota
- Ohio
- Oklahoma
- South Carolina
- South Dakota
- Tennessee
- Texas
- Utah
- West Virginia
- **Wyoming NEW (Effective July 14, 2023)**
