Users of the Statement of General Fund Cash Receipts and Disbursements

Attached are the Statements of General Fund Cash Receipts and Disbursements for the period July 1, 2002 through April 30, 2003. These statements reflect the State of California's General Fund cash position and compare actual receipts and disbursements for the 2002-03 fiscal year to cash flow estimates prepared by the Department of Finance for the 2003-04 Governor's Budget as well as the 2002-03 Budget Act. These statements are prepared in compliance with Government Code section 12461.1, as well as Item 0840-001-0001, Provision 10, of the 2002-03 Budget Act, using records compiled by the State Controller.

Since February 2003, certain General Fund payments were made by the General Cash Revolving Fund (GCRF). The GCRF was established as a preliminary step in the process to borrow externally by issuing Revenue Anticipation Warrants (RAWs). The issuance of the RAWs is authorized by Government Code section 16381 and will enable the General Fund to meet its obligations. The GCRF amounts have been combined with the General Fund for reporting purposes because they represent major General Fund type activities. (See Attachment C for details.)

Attachment A compares actual receipts and disbursements to date for the 2002-03 fiscal year to cash flow estimates published in the 2003-04 Governor's Budget. <u>The Governor's Budget cash flow</u> reflects an expected decrease of \$6.3 billion in receipts, and an expected decrease of \$996 million in disbursements from the Budget Act estimate for the 2002-03 fiscal year. These cash flow estimates are predicated on projections and assumptions made by the Department of Finance in preparation of the Governor's Budget.

Attachment B compares actual receipts and disbursements to date for the 2002-03 fiscal year to cash flow estimates prepared by the Department of Finance based upon the 2002-03 Budget Act. Prior year actual amounts are also displayed for comparative purposes.
