Announcing New On-Line Estates of Deceased Persons Data Release Date: Wednesday, June 12, 2013

The Unclaimed Property Division (UPD) is pleased to announce the release date for the Estates of Deceased Persons Data. For the first time this information will be available free of charge, in a downloadable Microsoft Excel Worksheet. **The Estates of Deceased Persons Data will no longer be available on CD-ROM for purchase.** This file will be available for download on Wednesday, June 12, 2013. The Estates of Deceased Persons file contains estates of deceased persons remitted to the State of California pursuant to Probate Code and CCP section 1300 et.seq. The Estates of Deceased Persons File displays these properties indexed by the following four categories: The State of California's Property ID Number, decedent's name, reported heir(s) and the property's available balance.


