Subject: Local Government Agency Advisory for Fiscal Years 2018-19 and 2019-20 due to COVID-19

This advisory provides information to counties, cities, towns, and special districts (local governments), and assists independent auditors in performing annual single audits of local governments for fiscal years 2018-19 and 2019-20. This advisory and general guidelines for single audits of local governments are available on the State Controller's Office (SCO) website at www.sco.ca.gov/aud_single_audits.html.

Office of Management and Budget (OMB) issued Memorandum M-20-17 dated March 19, 2020 – Administrative Relief for Recipients and Applicants of Federal Financial Assistance Directly Impacted by the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) due to Loss of Operations, extends the time for local government agencies to file their single audit reports with the Federal Audit Clearing House to six (6) months beyond the normal due date for reports that have fiscal year-ends through June 30, 2020. For most California entities, the reporting packages for fiscal years 2018-19 and 2019-20 are now due to SCO by September 30, 2020, and September 30, 2021, respectively.
