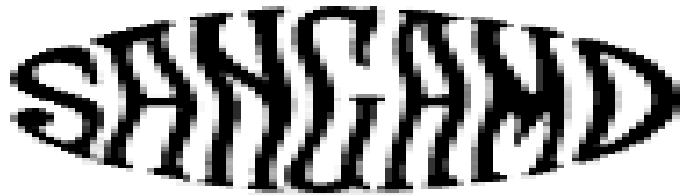

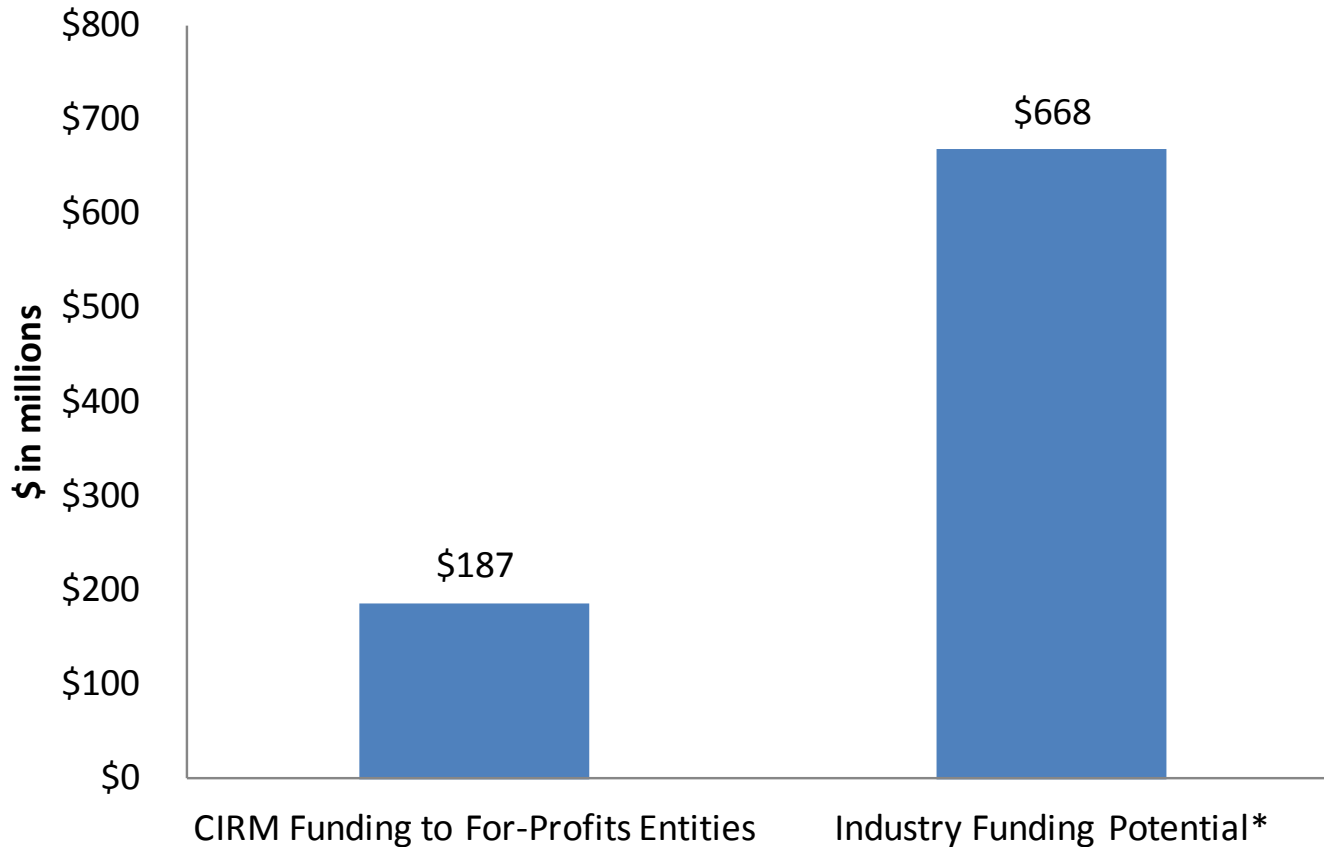

# Industry as a Source of Leverage

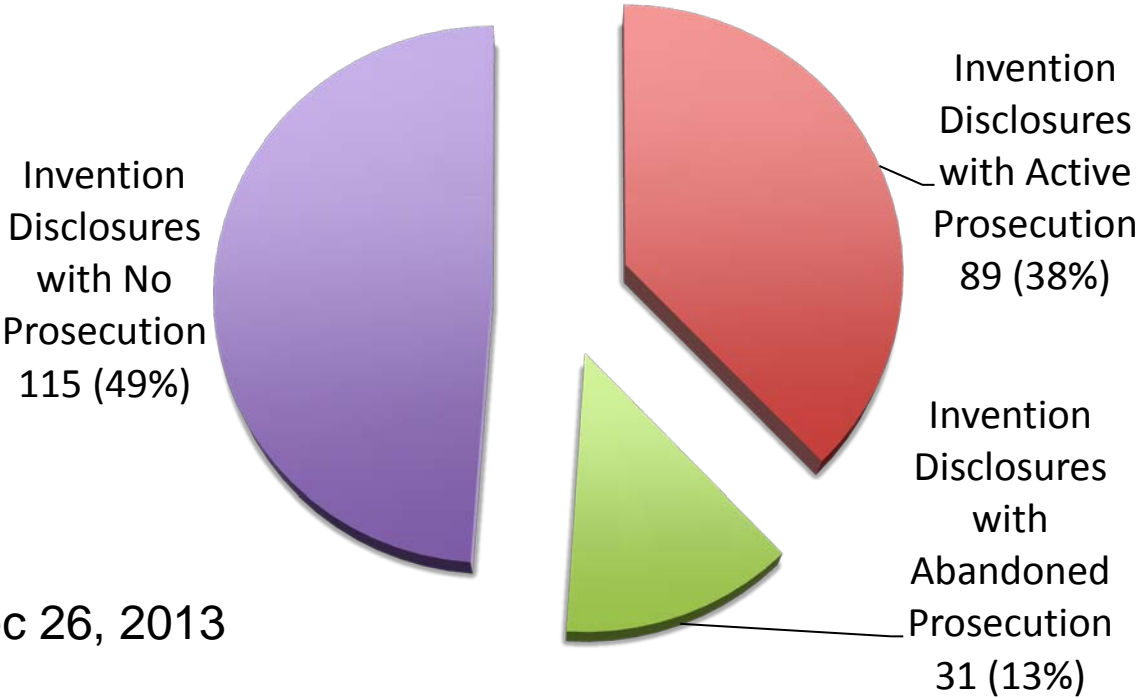
***CIRM funds to for-profits are being leveraged 3.6x with private sector funding, assuming satisfaction of all milestones***
