Subject: UPDATED - Memorandum of SCO Understanding of Pay Implementation

The State Controller's Office (SCO) is pleased to inform the employees of the California Association of Highway Patrolmen (Bargaining Unit 5) and California Association of Professional Scientists (Bargaining Unit 10) that the State Controller's Office is in the process of updating payroll records pursuant to the recently ratified contracts and Governor Newsom signing Assembly Bill 181 (Committee on the Budget). This memorandum is provided as an explanation of SCO's current understanding of how it will implement the same.

California Association of Highway Patrolmen (Bargaining Unit 5)

The SCO is working to implement the General Salary Increase (GSI) for eligible Bargaining Unit 5 employees. Those salary increases are expected to appear in their pay warrants beginning October 31, 2024. Eligible employees will also receive supplemental GSI payments beginning in October which will include their retroactive pay adjustments representing the period from July 1, 2024, through September 30, 2024.

California Association of Professional Scientists (Bargaining Unit 10)

The SCO is working to implement the Special Salary Adjustment for eligible Bargaining Unit 10 employees. Those salary increases are expected to appear in their pay warrants beginning October 31, 2024. Eligible members will also receive supplemental payments beginning in October which will include their retroactive pay adjustments representing the period from July 1, 2024, through September 30, 2024.
